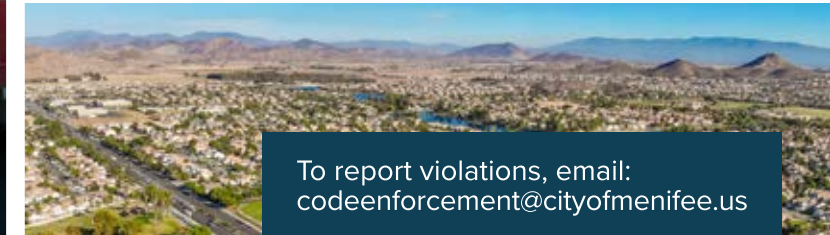

Three new code enforcement officers were recently hired to enforce municipal codes thanks to your investment in Measure DD. MENIFEE FIRE DEPARTMENT CLIMBS HIGHER WITH MEASURE DD

The fast-growing Meniffee Fire Department (FD), a contract service with CAL FIRE, is distinctly benefiting from Measure DD funding while investing in your safety.

The department recently rolled out a pair of Magnificent 7s, with 7 new Fire Captains coming on board (one for each Meniffee Fire station) and the formation of the versatile and vital Medic Patrol 7 Unit ran out of Fire Station #7. The unit is an emergency vehicle with full medical, rescue and firefighting capabilities. It has drastically improved 911 emergency response

times at one of the busiest stations with the highest call volume in Riverside County.

But perhaps the most exciting development at Meniffee FD is the recent purchase of a new ladder truck. This powerful new vehicle replaces the department's previous ladder truck, which had already outlived its operational expectancy. The new 101-foot, tractor-drawn vehicle is currently being built out by manufacturer KME Fire Apparatus, and is expected to be deployed for full operation in July 2020.



WHAT IS MEASURE DD?

Meniffee voters approved Measure DD, the 1% sales tax increase, by a convincing 68% in November 2016. Revenues from Measure DD are required to remain local and are used for critical City services like public safety and 911 emergency response services; keeping our roads, parks and infrastructure in good condition; and other general service needs that make Meniffee a desirable place to work, play and do business. The Measure DD Citizen Oversight Committee meets regularly and provides oversight on how Measure DD funds are spent to ensure the integrity of the measure.

EMPOWERING MENIFEE POLICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH MUNICIPAL POLICING

Measure DD continues to invigorate and elevate the newly-formed Menifee municipal Police Department (PD). Once officially launched in July 2020, the City of Menifee will take over policing efforts from the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, enhancing local control efforts and increasing safety, patrol hours and programming, while providing a cost savings to the City, compared to contract services with the County.

Seasoned law enforcement veteran, Pat Walsh, was appointed as Menifee's Police Chief in April 2019. Recruitment for Menifee PD's staff of 75, including officers and personnel is currently underway. Chief Walsh and Menifee's first two Police Captains, David Gutierrez,

and Christopher Karrer were sworn in on November 20 and have remained steadfast in the new Police Department formation.

Measure DD has also enabled a significant investment in new Menifee PD patrol vehicles, which are scheduled to be introduced in March 2020. These industry-leading, fully equipped vehicles will include high-quality technology, optimizing officer efficiency, communication and overall response times in Menifee." These existing response

times will be reduced due to Measure DD funding, which will help to pay for dispatch services through a partnership with the City of Murrieta. This direct investment made by residents will distinctly enhance the community's safety and quality of life.

"We have the ability to purchase vital policing equipment thanks to Measure DD," stated Police Chief Pat Walsh. "The community is investing in public safety, placing a high value on a premier level

of service to protect their families, personal investments and quality of life. Measure DD is the direct resource allowing us to do just that and we thank our residents for their investment."
